In the event that any successful applicant or supported student withdraws or is subject to cancellation of accreditation, the runner-up from this round of unsuccessful applicants may be moved up as the candidate for the support. Eligible students will be notified by the office via e-mail or telephone. The period of support for students who are selected for this additional selection will begin on the date of the decision to provide support and end on the date of the original scheduled end of support for the supported student who declined or withdrew, etc.

1. Response of acceptance by **Wednesday, June 11, 11:00 a.m. (JST)**

All successful applicants must respond.

Even if you withdraw from the application, your response is still required, so please be sure to respond by the deadline.

If you do not respond by the deadline, in principle, we will consider your application as withdrawn.

2. Payment of research incentives (equivalent to living expenses)

The first payment is scheduled for Friday, July 18. Only the first payment will be for 4 months (from April to July), and monthly payments will be made from August onward. If we need to revise or confirm the account information and passbook copy you submitted at the time of application, we will contact you after we have received your approval. Please note that the first payment may be delayed if the procedures are not completed in time or if you, an international student delay your arrival to Japan.

3. Payment of research funds

The issuance of budget codes, which are necessary for the use of research funds, is scheduled for late June.

In principle, you are required to purchase goods, etc. after the issuance of the budget code, but retroactive appropriation is possible for orders placed on or after June 16, 2025 (date of selection).

Please take all the training courses you are required to attend, as proper use of the research funds is required.

4. Attend supported student orientation (Zoom)

All newly selected supported students are required to attend. We will explain how to use research funds and cautionary notes, so the supported student academic supervisor and administrative support staff are encouraged to attend. The obligations in the latter half are for SPRING supported students, so please use them as a reference (you can leave).
