*About the additional selection

In the event that any successful applicant or supported student withdraws or is subject to cancellation of accreditation, the runner-up from this round of unsuccessful applicants may be moved up as the candidate for the support. Eligible students will be notified by the office via e-mail or telephone. The period of support for students who are selected for this additional selection will begin on the date of the decision to provide support and end on the date of the original scheduled end of support for the supported student who declined or withdrew, etc.

1. Response of acceptance by **Tuesday, December 2, 11:00 a.m. (JST)**

All successful applicants must respond.

Even if you withdraw from the application, your response is still required, so please be sure to respond by the deadline.

If you do not respond by the deadline, in principle, we will consider your application as withdrawn.

2. Payment of research incentives (equivalent to living expenses)

The first payment is scheduled for Tuesday, January 20. Only the first payment will be for 4 months (from October to January), and monthly payments will be made from February onward. If it is necessary to correct or confirm the transfer request form and a copy of the bankbook submitted at the time of application, we will contact you after receiving your approval, so please do so as soon as possible. Please note that the first payment may be delayed if the procedures are not completed in time or if you, an international student delay your arrival to Japan.

3. Payment of research funds

The issuance of budget codes, which are necessary for the use of research funds, is scheduled for middle

December.

• In principle, the purchase of goods, the application for travel expenses, etc., will be possible after the issuance of the budget code, but retroactive appropriation is possible for orders placed on or after December 5, 2025 (date of selection). However, the following actions taken before the support start date (date of selection) cannot be expensed or reimbursed from the program budget:

- Advance payments (立て替えた費用 - Costs paid out of pocket)
- Placing orders (発注)
- Inspection/Acceptance (検収 - including delivery or completion of services)
- Travel expense application (旅費申請 - including arrangement of air tickets, etc.)

• Cases judged to be ineligible for expenditure, even after payment has been completed, will be borne by the laboratory or the individual.

Please take all the training courses you are required to attend, as proper use of the research funds is required.

4. Watch the recording of the orientation for supported students

Recording 1: All newly hired supported students are required to watch this recording. The first half of Recording 1 explains the usage and precautions regarding research funds. Therefore, we strongly encourage the academic supervisors and administrative support staff of the Supported Students to watch this part as well. Please note that the content reflects information as of Spring 2025; kindly substitute the dates and periods as appropriate. You do not need to watch the latter half of the recording, as the obligations covered are solely for supported students of the SPRING program.
