All successful applicants must respond.

## 2. Payment of research incentives (equivalent to living expenses)

The first payment is scheduled for Tuesday, July 21. Only the first payment will be for 4 months (from April to July), and monthly payments will be made from August onward. If we need to revise or confirm the account information and passbook copy you submitted at the time of application, we will contact you after we have received your approval. Please note that the first payment may be delayed if the procedures are not completed in time or if you, an international student delay your arrival to Japan.

## 3. Payment of research funds

The issuance of budget codes, which are necessary for the use of research funds, is scheduled for late June.

· In principle, the purchase of goods, the application for travel expenses, etc., will be possible after the issuance of the budget code, but retroactive appropriation is possible for orders placed on or after December 5, 2025 (date of selection). However, the following actions taken before the support start date (date of selection) cannot be expensed or reimbursed from the program budget:

- Advance payments (立て替えた費用 - Costs paid out of pocket)
- Placing orders (発注)
- Inspection/Acceptance (検収 - including delivery or completion of services)
- Travel expense application (旅費申請 - including arrangement of air tickets, etc.)

· Cases judged to be ineligible for expenditure, even after payment has been completed, will be borne by the laboratory or the individual.

Please take all the training courses you are required to attend, as proper use of the research funds is required.

## 4. Attend supported student orientation (Zoom)

All newly selected supported students are required to attend. We will explain how to use research funds and cautionary notes, so the supported student academic supervisor and administrative support staff are encouraged to attend.

- Date and time: June 26th (Fri), June 29th (Mon), or July 1st (Wed)

The exact date and time will be finalized after coordinating with all Selected Applicants based on the tentative dates above.

We will send you a separate email in due course, so please wait until then for further updates.

## 5. Sharing with relevant parties

Please be sure to inform your academic supervisor who will be Budget Execution Manager.

If you are being treated as a dependent by a person who is obligated to support you (such as a parent) for health insurance, support allowance, etc., in principle, you need to be removed as a dependent. Please be sure to contact the person who is obligated to support you.
